

Minutes of Annesley & Felley Parish Council meeting held at Annesley Parish Hall on 2nd October 2017 at 7.00pm.

Present: Cllr's J Zadrozny, J Bell, D Martin, A Cope, PD Thomas, R Madden, V Heslop, W O'Brien, one member of the public, the Clerk and John Saint were in attendance.

The meeting was chaired by Cllr J Zadrozny.

1 Apologies for Absence: Cllr's A Wortley, H Wortley, T Smith, W Beasley and H Simmons.

2 Declarations of Personal & Prejudicial Interest: None

3 Public Questions:

- 3.1 Member of the Public reported that the overgrown trees on Moseley Road were damaging overhead telephone lines. It was agreed that the issue would be reported again to Nott's CC.
- 3.2 Member of the Public reported that the hedges around the allotment site, off Recreation Road, required cutting. It was agreed that Anthony Clarke would be requested to carry out the work.
- 3.3 Member of the Public asked if the allotment tenants could have bonfires on the allotment site off Recreation Road. Although the allotment tenancy agreements prohibit bonfires it was agreed that during the first week of November 2017 bonfires could be lit just for this seven day period.
- 3.4 Member of the Public reported that speeding traffic was an ongoing problem within the village. It was agreed that Cllr R Madden would look at the feasibility of having a "sleeping policeman" installed on Mosely Road and the Clerk would contact Nottinghamshire Police Authority about having regular speed checks on Annesley Cutting, particularly at weekends.
- 3.5 Member of the Public reported that building waste/rubbish was being dumped, in close proximity to 33, Forest Road, on public land. It was agreed that the issue would be reported to ADC Planning Dept.

4 To accept the minutes of the meeting held on 4th September 2017: Minutes of the meeting were accepted as a true record of the meeting and signed by the Chair of the meeting.

5 Matters Arising:

- 5.1 It was agreed that before the November Parish Council meeting Nott's CC should be asked for their suggestions/recommendations for the potential use of the Cemetery Mortuary Chapel.
- 5.2 For Xmas 2017 a Xmas tree should be sited at the top of Moseley Road. Cllr J Zadrozny reported that ADC will not fund a Xmas tree this year. Cllr J Zadrozny has now contacted Nott's CC for permission for a planted tree at the top of Moseley Road. Subject to permission being granted the Parish Council will purchase a suitable Xmas tree.
- 5.3 Representative from the Fire Authority to be asked to visit the Parish Hall to give advice on the location of the fire extinguishers. This issue will now be addressed during the Fire Safety Survey being carried out on 4th October 2017 by Graham Wood.
- 5.4 Quotes to be obtained from an external company for a "no parking - keep clear" message on the tarmac to the entrance of the new car park extension.
- 5.5 Hoot Fire & Security Ltd has offered to provide additional training for the new CCTV system. It was agreed that a number of Parish Councillors should attend the training; therefore Cllr PD Thomas will obtain available dates and arrange the training.
- 5.6 Regular Parish Council newsletter. It was agreed that the publication of a newsletter will be deferred to a later date.
- 5.7 Advert for the recruitment of volunteer Youth Workers has been produced. Copies of the advert have now been printed.
- 5.8 The bulbs in the outside lights around the Hall require replacing.
- 5.9 Some repointing of the step at the front of the Parish Hall is required. The work is to be carried out before the November meeting.

- 7.1 It was agreed that Cllr R Madden will contact Will Kent (ADC) with regards to funding opportunities and Project management for a project to improve play facilities to include repairs to the existing floor covering on the children's play area.
