Minutes of Annesley & Felley Parish Council meeting held at Annesley Parish Hall on 6th March 2017 at 7.00pm.

The meeting was chaired by Cllr T Smith.

- 1 Apologies for Absence: Cllr's H Wortley, V Heslop, W O'Brien, J Bell, D Martin and R Madden.
- 2 Declarations of Personal & Prejudicial Interest: None

3 Public Questions:

- 3.1 Member of the Public reported that there had been an increase in the number of vehicles speeding on Annesley Cutting since the road had been resurfaced. Cllr J Zadrozny agreed to try and arrange for a temporary interactive speed limit sign.
- 4 <u>To accept the minutes of the meeting held on 6th February 2017:</u> Minutes of the meeting were accepted as a true record of the meeting and signed by the Chair of the meeting.

5 Matters Arising:

- 5.1 The specification for the Cemetery Extension Project was agreed. Quotes will now be obtained from three Contractors.
- 5.2 Request for additional street lighting to be installed near 1 Warren Avenue.
- 5.3 To protect the Cemetery Mortuary Chapel from further deterioration options are to be considered for the development of the Chapel. It was agreed that Nott's CC should be commissioned to carry out a feasibility study (free of charge) to establish the suitability for development for business or commercial use.
- 5.4 Street light number 14, on Byron Road, is still faulty. Report the fault yet again to Nott's CC.
- 5.5 For Xmas 2017 a Xmas tree should be sited at the top of Moseley Road. The Parish Council agreed to look at the potential cost to enable a decision to be made.
- 5.6 To stop further damage to the Parish Hall caused by football being played in front of the Hall it was agreed that quotes should be obtained to extend the metal rail at the front of the Hall.
- 5.7 Grassed areas are being damaged during grass cutting. Issue reported to Anthony Clarke (Contractor) on 7th February 2017
- 5.8 Tree is obstructing the foot path on School Hill. No action to be taken.
- 5.9 The car park extension is now complete. To define the actual parking area it was agreed that wooden posts would be purchased and quotes obtained for the installation of the posts.
 - It was agreed that a quote would be obtained from ADC for the supply of signage for the car parking areas.
- 5.10 Quotes to be obtained to increase the CCTV coverage within the Parish Hall.
- 5.11 Amendments to the draft Youth Club Constitution were agreed and the final document will now be approved at the Parish Council meeting on 3rd April 2017.

6 Chair's Urgent Items

6.1 Fly tipping to the rear of Byron Road was discussed at length. It was agreed that Cllr J Zadrozny would try and get a representative from ADC to attend the site on 3rd April 2017 at 6.00pm to advise the Parish Council on the action to be taken. Confirmation of this will be sent to all Councillors.

7.1 It was confirmed that two new bus stops will be created on Newstead Road close to Stewart Way.

8 Youth Club

- 8.1 Cllr PD Thomas confirmed that the Youth Club asset register had now been checked and updated.
- 8.2 The average attendance at the Youth Club was currently around seventeen.
- 8.3 Cllr PD Thomas confirmed that the Youth Club would be closed on Wednesday 15th March 2017.

9 <u>Cemetery</u>

9.1 The guttering on the Mortuary Chapel requires clearing out. It was agreed that Anthony Clarke would be instructed to carry out the work.

10 Parish Hall

- 10.1 Hall bookings were reviewed and agreed.
- 10.2 It was agreed that the Parish Hall should be advertised in the Church magazine for a further year. A new advert is to be produced to include details of the additional car parking facilities at the Hall and also the planned events for 2017 should be included.
- 10.3 Representative from the Fire Authority to be asked to visit the Parish Hall to give advice on the location of the fire extinguishers.
