

**Minutes of the Annesley & Felley Annual Parish Meeting held  
on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019 - 6.00pm - at the Parish Hall - Annesley**

**1. Apologies for Absence:** None

**2. Approval of Minutes of the previous meeting held on Monday 14<sup>st</sup> May 2018.**

It was noted that the minutes had been accepted and signed as a true record of the meeting at the Parish Council meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

**3. Annual Report**

The Chair gave a brief summary of events and achievements throughout the year.

- a) It was noted that all thirteen Parish Councillors had served during the 2018/19 year. However at the Parish Council election held on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2019 six Parish Councillors were re-elected, six new Parish Councillors were elected and the vacancy for the Felley ward was not filled.
- b) The 2019/20 Precept has again not been increased. The Precept was last increased in 2016/17.
- c) In November 2018 the Parish Council celebrated the World War 1 Centenary. A metal "Tommy" silhouette was purchased and erected on Annesley Cutting and 250 lamp post poppies were sited throughout the Parish.
- d) The Cemetery extension is now complete and available for use. The plan for the new extended area has now been produced resulting in circa 170 additional grave plots.
- e) During the year the Parish Council fully supported the Ashfield District Council - "Art Feature" project. The Project is will be completed in spring 2019.
- f) In February 2019 the Parish Council submitted a funding application to Nott's CC LIS scheme for £20,000 to improve recreational facilities within the Parish.
- g) During the year the Parish Council completed work on the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) legislation to become GDPR compliant in May 2018.
- h) The Chair thanked all Parish Councillors, past and present, Anthony Clarke (Groundsman), John Saint (Caretaker) and John Barlow (Clerk) for their contribution throughout the year.
