**3. Annual Report**

The Chair gave a brief summary of events and achievements throughout the year.

- a) During the year two Parish Councillors had resigned and two new Parish Councillors had been appointed by co-option.
- b) The 2018/19 Precept was not increased.
- c) The Youth Club remains successful and is still supported by paid Youth Workers. A vote of thanks was expressed to Cllr PD Thomas for all of his hard work in making the Youth Club successful.
- d) During the year the Parish Council has made significant progress on some of the projects identified in the latest Parish Plan. The Parish Hall car park extension has now been totally completed and the work on the Cemetery extension has also been completed. Also new internal and external CCTV cameras have been installed at the Parish Hall. The Parish Plan will be continually updated. It has now been confirmed by Nott's County Council that the LIS funding bid to improve recreational facilities in the village has not been successful.

The Chair thanked all Parish Councillors, past and present, Anthony Clarke (Groundsman), John Saint (Caretaker) and John Barlow (Clerk) for their contribution throughout the year.
