

**Minutes of the Annesley & Felley Annual Parish Meeting held  
on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at Annesley Parish Hall commencing at 6.30pm**

**2. Approval of Minutes of the previous meeting held on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2021.**

**3. Annual Report**

The Chair gave a brief summary of events and achievements throughout the year.

- a) The 2022/23 Parish Council Precept has not been increased - the last increase was in 2016/17.
- b) During 2021/22 the Parish Council completed the following Projects:
  - Large Xmas tree decorated and sited on Annesley Cutting
  - The old pit truck is now fully refurbished and is utilised as a flower planter at the entrance to Annesley Cutting.
  - Additional information signage has now been installed at the Pit Wheel monument on Annesley Cutting
  - Purchase of litter picking equipment to support local Community Litter Picks
  - Planted additional spring bulbs and wild flower seeds on the green space between Byron and Moseley Road. Also carried out additional planting in the refurbished pit truck on Annesley Cutting.
  - Carried out grounds maintenance improving the appearance and safety within the village - cleared overgrown shrubbery around the bus stop on Annesley Cutting and at the junction of Byron Road/Annesley Cutting to improve visibility for vehicle access.
- c) The Chair thanked all past and present Parish Councillors, Anthony Clarke (Groundsman), John Saint (Caretaker) and John Barlow (Clerk) for their contribution throughout the year.
