

Minutes of the Annesley and Felley Council meeting held on 4th May 2010 in the Parish Hall.

Present: Councillors, P D Thomas, J Chisholm, A Cope, B Wortley, M Wilkinson, PCSO A Fichna, 1 member of the Public and the Clerk were also in attendance.

1. **Apologies for Absence:** received from Councillors J Longden, M A Thomas, S Wilkinson
2. **Declaration of interest:** none declared
3. **To accept the minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 13th April 2010:** The Minutes of the meeting were accepted as a true record and signed by Cllr J Chisholm who Chaired the meeting.
4. **Matters Arising**
 - 4.1. Dog fouling on the land between Byron Road, Moseley Road and School Hill is still a problem, it is requested that the Dog Warden continues to visit the area.
 - 4.2. There is still a serious problem with vehicles mounting the pavement at the Annesley Cutting junction. Cllr R Madden has arranged a site visit with the relevant parties to discuss the issues.
 - 4.3. Cllr P D Thomas met with K Gee (ADC) to look at additional low level lighting around the children's play area and playing field. K Gee agreed to provide details of possible funding options and quotes. Follow up with K Gee required.
 - 4.4. Cllr J Longden agreed to install the new notice board in the cemetery by the next meeting.
 - 4.5. Member of the public asked if a grit bin could be installed at the bottom of Moseley Road.
 - 4.6. Cllr P D Thomas reported that fly tipping was still a problem on Station Road. Reply has been received from Trevor Middleton (ADC) and they will continue to keep the Council updated. The clerk was asked to report to Trevor Middleton that drugs (cannabis) had also been found in this area.
 - 4.7. Cllr J Chisholm asked the Clerk to inform Cllr's R Madden and T D Theaker that the Parish Councils understanding was that the ADC- S106 money was secured and "ring fenced" for developments within the Woodhouse Ward.
 - 4.8. Decision to be made on the investment options for the surplus funds.

10.2. Cllr A Cope reported that some of the trees on the land between Moseley Road and Byron Road, owned by Nott's CC, were in need of cutting. The Clerk was asked to check the lease agreement to establish who was responsible for the maintenance of these trees.

10.3. Cllr P D Thomas suggested that residents should be encouraged to take on the maintenance of the flower planters around the village. This was agreed.

11. Youth Club

11.1. Youth Club continues to be successful with the attendance increasing. A number of events are planned for 2010 details of which can be seen on the new website.

11.2. The Youth Club has received funding of £1,000 from Nott's CC for sports equipment. The Youth Club wish to thank Cllr R Madden for her help in securing this funding.

11.3. The new seat/bench (BBC project), designed by the Youth Club, has now been installed.

12.1. Cllr J Longden reported that the area close to Grave A577 may require some maintenance work. Anthony Clarke has agreed to tidy the area around the grave.

13.1. Parish Hall Bookings were discussed and agreed.

13.2. It was agreed that now the funding is in place a Steering Group will be formed to plan/ manage the Parish Hall refurbishment.
